

Driving Directions to Ashton Tweed

From King of Prussia

○ Follow Rte 202 S to the 76, 422, and Swedesford Rd exit, just after the intersection of 202 and N. Gulph Rd at the southwest corner of the King of Prussia Mall. Follow the signs for Swedesford Rd. At the traffic light take a left onto Swedesford Rd. 565 Swedesford is just after the 2nd traffic light, on the right. Ashton Tweed is in Suite 214, on the 2nd floor, down the hallway to the left after getting off the elevator.

From Philadelphia International Airport

○ Follow the signs for I-95 S towards Wilmington, DE. Proceed on I-95 S and exit onto Rte 476 N (approx. 5 miles) and head towards Plymouth Meeting. Exit onto I-76 W towards King of Prussia / Valley Forge and proceed to the 422/Swedesford Rd exit. Follow signs for Swedesford Rd. At the traffic light take a left onto Swedesford Rd. 565 Swedesford is just after the 2nd traffic light, on the right. Ashton Tweed is in Suite 214, on the 2nd floor, down the hallway to the left after getting off the elevator.

From Philadelphia (30th Street Train Station)

○ Follow the signs for I-76 W. Once on I-76 W proceed to the 422/Swedesford Rd exit (approx. 20 miles). Follow signs for Swedesford Rd. At the traffic light take a left onto Swedesford Rd. 565 Swedesford is just after the 2nd traffic light, on the right. Ashton Tweed is in Suite 214, on the 2nd floor, down the hallway to the left after getting off the elevator.

From Wilmington, Delaware

○ Follow I-95 N to Rte 202 N (also called Wilmington/Concordville Pike). Proceed on Rte 202 N and exit at Valley Forge Rd N/W Valley Rd (approx 30 miles). At the light, turn left to go back under the highway (202), and when on the other side of the highway, take a right onto E. Swedesford Rd. 565 E. Swedesford is on the left about 1/5 mile down, the entrance is before the light. There is no entrance from the light. Ashton Tweed is in Suite 214, on the 2nd floor, down the hallway to the left after getting off the elevator.
